Barb Hamilton brought up that Irene had a document from China Creek Internet about getting high-speed service for our area. Interested people were asked to sign the document.

There was discussion regarding ATV's and motorcycles on public roads and riding in Riparian Areas. We talked about finding alternative areas to ride.

Mr. Harry Lali arrived at the meeting. He spoke about the dangers of riding ATV's. Mr. Lali agreed to help us with our Community Plan. Susan Dixon agreed to send him a copy of the current community plan.

Motion was made by Susan Kaltenegger to keep membership dues the same at \$20 per family. Moe Dufour seconded it.
