I have included with this fax a letter sent to the Minister of Forests for the Government of BC, Steve Thomson. I have also sent similar letters to Harry Lali, MLA for our region , Terry Lake, Minister of the Environment, and Brad Hope, Regional Director for Area H.

Although I do not have the exact details of the proposed logging operation I attended a meeting of the Allison Lake Water District where they were discussed as your company had sent them notification. The proposed logging at Stringer Lake directly impacts part of the Allison Creek watershed and furthermore, Anderson Creek, the creek that feeds the Allison Lake Water Improvement District alternate reservoir.

As you can see from the letter I have sent to Steve Thomson, this is in direct conflict with a long standing plan to protect the small Allison Creek headwaters so that over a hundred home owners have adequate water resources.
